1.	<p>Do I understand correctly that proposal must be submitted regarding all three position levels (P1, P2 and P3)? Can we bid only on the P3 level we specialize in?</p> <p><i>(Note from the Procurement commission: the question was translated into English using a machine translator.)</i></p>	<p>The Procurement commission explains that the subject-matter of the open competition is recruitment services – in the Baltic States (Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia) in accordance with Annex No 2 "Technical specification / Technical proposal form" of the Regulations (please see the Section 6.1. of the Regulations). Additionally, the subject-matter of the open competition is not divided in parts (lots). The Tenderer must submit a Proposal only for the whole subject-matter of the open competition in total (please see the section 6.2. of the Regulations).</p> <p>It follows from the Procurement documentation that the contract must be executed for all three position-level candidates (P1, P2, and P3), and accordingly, the proposal must be submitted for all three position-level candidates, according to requirements stipulated in the Regulations. In the event when proposal will be submitted only for a part of the required position level candidates, it will be recognized as non-compliant to the requirements of the Regulations and will not be evaluated.</p> <p>In addition, the Procurement commission emphasizes that if the interested supplier specializes only in a certain field of position level</p>

		(i.e., in such case recruiting P3 level candidates), it can submit the proposal together with other cooperation partners, for example, submitting proposal as a partnership, or rely on the capabilities of another person for the performance of certain works (please pay attention to the Section 7, 9 and 10 of the Regulations).
