As it is repeating of the same information.</p> <p>(we are submitting our proposal as partnership)</p> <p>Please also approve that there is no need to fill Annex No8 (subcontractors) if submitting as partnership.</p>	<p>The Procurement commission explains that each annex of the Procurement Regulations has its own meaning, and if the Tenderer has decided to rely on the capabilities of other person(s), then in accordance with the Procurement Regulation (e.g., Section 9 and 13.3), Annex No 7 is one of the documents which must be submitted, despite the fact that that information may be repeated.</p> <p>At the same time, the Procurement commission informs that it cannot give specific instructions in the preparation of interested supplier's proposal.</p> <p>The interested supplier, depending on the form of cooperation, must evaluate identifiable information in the proposal documents, in accordance with the requirements of the Procurement Regulations.</p> <p>The Procurement commission points out that according to Article 1, point 1 of the Public Procurement Law of the Republic of Latvia (hereinafter – PPL), a subcontractor is "a person contracted by the tenderer or a person contracted by such person, in its turn, who [...] provides services for the performance of the procurement contract".</p>

		<p>Also, in accordance with the Section 7.1.2 of the Procurement Regulations, a group of suppliers (also partnership) is considered as Tenderer. Therefore, if the requirements specified in the subcontractor definition of PPL are met (for example, partnership contracted a person for the performance of a procurement contract), then the interested supplier must complete and submit Annex No 8 of the Procurement Regulations.</p>
