SDM has also significant leadership responsibility to build and motivate the team to commit to achieve the program objectives.

Responsibilities

- SDM is responsible for developing and aligning the “Operational Section” objectives with the RBGP’s strategic goals. They work closely with stakeholders at various levels to define the program’s scope, objectives, and outcomes.
- Implement effective governance frameworks, policies, and procedures to ensure the successful execution of the program. Define roles and responsibilities, establish communication channels, and monitor progress against defined metrics.
- Provide leadership that binds the program functions into a team to work cooperatively toward common goals. Manage internal relationships and provide opportunities for personnel learning, development.
- Support EU and State financing Application process for their Operational Section. Ensure that progress of the program is aligned with time constraints to use the funds. Ensure that data and documents required to support reconciliation with Grant Agreement are recorded all along the program duration.
- Implement system assurance standards and processes to ensure that deliverables assure adequate reliability, availability, maintainability and safety (RAMS) of the entire rail system.
- Identify, assess, and prioritize risks, and develop strategies to mitigate or respond to them
- Oversee the allocation and utilisation of resources across multiple activities within the program. Ensure that procurement process organised to start works on time.
