There is not possibility to propose, for example 3 experts, to obtain more points Procurement commission will evaluate only one key expert with the widest experience who will be proposed to comply with qualification criteria stipulated in item 1.1 of Section 7.4. The same evaluation methodology will be used in cases with criteria b.2, b.3, b.5 - b.7.
So for this example below, if we consider the points of the whole team, the total amount of projects of the team is 9 projects => 4 points. 20.7.1.1.1. and evaluation methodology, procurement commission will assign extra points for relevant expert or experts for experience which exceeds the minimum experience requirements. For example, if six proposed key experts will cover all disciplines according minimum requirements, only these six experts shall be evaluated and no more. Experience of all experts shall be summarized, also in cases when two experts have participated in one railway project modelling and delivering assets in a BIM environment but covering different disciplines. In cases when two or more experts will be proposed to cover the same discipline (for example communications and utilities), only expert with the widest experience shall be evaluated.
